### Beacon & North Beacon Street – 30 ft wide

Overall concept – remove double yellow, define the travel way with edge lines 18 feet apart, resulting in 2 6 ft parking lanes along side an 18 ft carriage way.

### Intersection: Beacon & West Blvd.

- 1. Mark crosswalks with paint
- 2. Mark dashed bike lane through the intersection box
- 3. Painted and delineated neck down

#### Block: West to Warrenton

- 1. Consider alternating parking and chicanes
- 2. Consider mid-block neck down or offset bumpouts

#### Intersection: Beacon & Warrenton

- 1. Mark crosswalks with paint
- 2. Consider painted and delineated neck down
- 3. Consider neighborhood mini circle

# **Block:** Warrenton to Farmington

- 1. Mark approach to speed humps with paint
- 2. Consider alternating parking and chicanes
- 3. Consider mid-block neck down at fire hydrant

## Intersection: Beacon & Farmington

- 1. Median refuges for pedestrians
- 2. Not a popular idea: Consider a snake diverter
- 3. Not a popular idea: Consider triangular diverters

## Block: Farmington to Cone

- 1. Consider alternating parking and chicanes
- 2. Consider neck down at mid-block fire hydrant

#### Intersection: N Beacon & Cone

1. Neighborhood mini circle

## Block: Cone to Fern

1. Consider neck down at the mid-block fire hydrant

#### Intersection: N Beacon & Fern

1. Consider painted and delineated curb extensions and bump outs

# Block: Fern to Elizabeth

- 1. Consider alternating parking with chicanes, 8' parking, 18' travel, 4' shoulder
- 2. Consider neck down at mid-block fire hydrant
- 3. Consider planting street trees

## Intersection: N Beacon & Elizabeth

- 1. Painted intersection box
- 2. Consider neck downs
- 3. Consider diverting traffic
- 4. Consider closing traffic
