

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The existing 100 Pearl Street structure incorporates the historic 60 Pearl Street Mechanics Savings Bank facade, in addition to the more modern high rise office building constructed in 1989 and other alterations.

The Applicant previously met with the Historic Preservation Commission on November 18, 2020, when the Commission approved their proposal. The November approval extended to seven signs.

## These included:

- 1. One 15'x15' (225 sf) internally illuminated logo on parapet wall on west elevation.
- 2. One 9'x82'-3 1/4" (740 sf) "Hartford HealthCare" channel letterset on north elevation
- 3. One 5'\_1 3/16" x 46'\_7 1/16" (238 sf) "Hartford HealthCare" channel letterset on south elevation.
- 4. Four 10' x 3' (30 sf) permanent banners on the south façade in the location of the historic 100 Pearl Street Corning Building

# **PROPOSED REVISIONS**

The Applicant is proposing to modify the November approval. The proposed changes include:

- 1. The internally illuminated logo installed on the parapet wall of the west elevation would be reduced to 12' x 12'.
- 2. No change is proposed to the "Hartford HealthCare" channel letterset on the north elevation
- 3. The Applicant proposes to increase the size of the channel letterset sign on the south elevation to 7' x 63' 4 3/4" (443.8 sf)
- 4. The Applicant proposes to install four 10' x 3' aluminum projecting signs on the south façade in the location of the historic 100 Pearl Street Corning Building, a change from the banner signs which were previously proposed.

### LEGAL STANDARD

The Commission reviews and acts upon all applications for Document of Suitability. No person or entity may, without first applying and obtaining the approval of the Commission, file an application for a demolition permit, or for a building permit for any protected property as designated in the Historic Preservation Ordinance Sec. 28-219.

### STANDARD SPECIFIC TO THE USE

The commission shall adopt the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and the Hartford Guidelines for Renovations and Additions to Historic Buildings.

According to page 39- "Storefronts" of the adopted Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation; "Using inappropriately scaled signs and logos or other types of signs that obscure, damage, or

destroy remaining character-defining features of the historic building." is NOT recommended and "If features of the structural system are exposed such as brick walls, cast iron columns, roof trusses, posts and heams, vigas, or stone foundation walls, they may be important in defining the building's overall historic character."

# FINDING OF FACTS

**BUILDING USE:** Mixed Use

YEAR BUILT: 1924, 1989 STYLE: Neoclassical, Modern

**Particular Mention in historic nomination:** Two historic structures remain at 100 Pearl Street which are particularly mentioned in the nomination to contribute to the state historic district:

- 80 Pearl Street, Mechanics Savings Bank, built in 1924, is noted for being one of Hartford's older financial institutions and the work of architects Morris & O'Connor. Architecturally the building is noted for its granite façade, Greek Doric columns, and other Greek inspired details.
- 100 Pearl Street, Corning Building, built in 1934, is noted for its avant-garde design that is unique in Historic Downtown Hartford. Designed by the Hartford Architect Lester B. Scheide, the building relies "for effect on fine materials, varied planes and sensitive massing rather than on architectural embellishment. In the front elevation a central recessed section of polished black granite is flanked by projecting limestone masses on a black granite base..."

**Current Conditions:** This building is in good condition.




Figure 5. Google Streetview, dated June 2019. View from the subject property looking west along Pearl Street.




Figure 7. Rendering and details of proposed aluminum blade signage, south elevation.




Figure 8. Satellite plan of proposed signage, taken from Attachment 4 of this report. Depicts the locations of the proposed signage on the north, west, and south elevations of the building.

# **ANALYSIS**

The structure at 100 Pearl Street is a unique combination of historic facades from the early 20<sup>th</sup> century with Greek and Art Moderne styles and more modern high-rise alterations. Historical photographs of 100 Pearl Street, the historic Corning Building, show that while a recessed section of black granite in the front façade and the raised disc with lettering exist today as acknowledgements to the historic architectural details, the historic façade has largely been replaced.

The applicant proposes 3 modifications to the proposal:

The Applicant proposes to reduce the area of the internally illuminated logo sign on the parapet of the west elevation from 15' x 15' to 12' x 12'. The sign will have a negligible impact on the historic character of Downtown Hartford, even at the size approved in November. The reduction should further mitigate any negative impact.

The Applicant proposes to increase the area of the channel set sign on the south elevation, from 238 sf to 443 sf. The width of the sign would increase from 5' 1 3/16" to 7' while the length would increase from approximately 46' 7 1/16" to 63' 4 3/4". The sign would thus be significantly larger. Still, the proposed larger sign would not differ significantly from existing signage in the downtown skyline.

The Applicant proposes to install four aluminum blade signs as opposed to the four banners originally approved. The proposed signs would use 2" x 2" aluminum tubing. Like the banners approved in November, the proposed aluminum signs would be 3' x 10'. The proposed signage would also have the same graphic as those approved in November. Its design does mimic the 1934 Corning Building, but the proposed signage would not detract from the design itself.

The fourth approved sign, a 9'x82'-3 1/4" (740 sf) "Hartford HealthCare" channel letterset on north elevation, is not proposed to be modified by this application.

Staff recommends approval of the proposed signage. The proposed signage must undergo a separate zoning review to ensure compliance with the Zoning Regulations.

# **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends approval of this application.

Whereas, The channel letterset sign on the south elevation would be increased from 5' 1 3/16" x 46' 7 1/16" (238 sf) to 7' x 63' 4 3/4" (443.8 sf); and

Whereas, The materiality of the four 10' x 3' projecting signs on the south façade in the location of the historic 100 Pearl Street Corning Building would be changed from vinyl banners to aluminum projecting signs; and

**Whereas,** The proposed signage will not detract from the historic character of the structure; and
