Hello Dave,

I'm reaching out to let you know that the public hearing date for this application will need to be **postponed to the following Commission meeting, Tuesday October 11**. My sincere apologies for the change of plans.

As we were re-reviewing the application, we realized that it should have been processed – and therefore also advertised – as a request for two special permits: a special permit for dynamic display per <u>Section 8.12.3</u>, as well as a special permit for deviations from the sign regulations for DT districts per <u>Section 8.1.3.(E)</u>. This is because the overall signage on the parcel will exceed what is permitted by-right, and because the proposed sign type doesn't fit neatly within the sign classification. As such, we want to make sure the application is properly advertised so as to avoid any issues down the road.

Given that this is our error, we'd be happy resend the corrected notices to abutting property owners. I can also update the posted signs, assuming they are accessible from the sidewalk. You would still be responsible for getting the form renotarized with the corrected dates.

Also, there will be an additional fee for the additional special permit (\$350). I can send over fee payment information in the next day or two.

Again, I apologize for this oversight. I'll give you a call in a few minutes to make sure you've received my message and to answer any questions.



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Good morning Dave,

In addition to the public noticing requirements, Staff have a few comments and questions regarding your special permit application. We'd appreciate if you could provide a response by next Wednesday 9/21, or sooner if possible. Feel free to reach out with any clarifying questions.

- 1. A letter of authorization, a sign spec sheet, and stand-alone drawings (elevations + site plan) were submitted when you submitted your HPC application, but not re-submitted when you applied online for the special permit. Just wanted to note that I'm going to copy these files to your Special Permit application. I've attached them here for reference. Let me know if you have any concerns.
- 2. Please revise the elevation drawings to notate the distance shown in yellow on screenshot below.
- 3. Dynamic display signs are regulated by Section 8.12 of the Zoning Regulations (<u>available online here</u>), including specifically the display requirements of Section 8.12.3.E.
 - a. Please confirm in writing that the proposed display meets the requirements of Section 8.12.3.E subsections (1) through (6). Please also add these as notes somewhere on the plan set or specs sheet.
 - b. Please provide a written certification from the sign manufacturer to satisfy Section 8.12.3.E.(7). It seems that while the signs' proposed daytime brightness (2,100 nits) is within the permitted 5,000 nits, the proposed nighttime brightness (900 nits) exceeds what is permitted by the Regulations (250 nits).
 - c. For your reference, the property does not border an N district so subsection (8) does not apply in your case.
- 4. Is it correct that the proposed LED technology provides 73% transparency when on, and full transparency when off? Do you already have set times during which you plan to turn the signs on/off? Note that Staff and/or the Planning & Zoning Commission will likely recommend limiting the hours during the which the sign may be on.
