WHEREAS, The City of Hartford's Department of Health and Human Services served as a Health Enhancement Community (HEC)-Reference Community in 2018 and a HEC Pre-Planning grantee in 2019; and

WHEREAS, HEC grants funds have been provided to the City by the Connecticut Office of Health Strategy, and such funds are managed by the Hartford Department of Health & Human Services; and

WHEREAS, The City will submit a grant application for funding of \$25,000 under the HEC Pre-Planning Phase II for the period of February 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, These funds will be allocated through a contract to the United Way of Central and Northeastern Connecticut, the fiscal agent of the North Hartford Triple Aim Collaborative, to provide services in support of the grant; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Hartford Court of Common Council hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Hartford to apply for and accept a grant of \$25,000 from the State of Connecticut, Office of Health Strategy (OHS), and to enter into a contract with OHS to accept \$25,000 for the purpose of supporting "The HBC Pre-Planning Phase II" project; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Mayor is authorized to accept such further sums as may be additionally awarded by the grantor under the same program, for the same authorized contract period, and for the same purposes; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all manner of documents and to take such other actions as he and the Corporation Counsel may deem appropriate and in the best interests of the City in order to receive, contract, and expend the State of Connecticut Office of Health Strategy funds; and be it further

RESOLVED, That no person or entity shall be entitled to rely on, or otherwise claim any benefit by reason of this resolution should the Mayor fail to execute the aforementioned agreements or other documents, or to take any of the other aforesaid actions; and be it further

RESOLVED, That all approvals and authorizations provided hereby are contingent upon, and only shall be effective on and by means of, the Mayor executing such agreements and documents, and taking such actions, all of which shall be, in form and substance, acceptable to the Mayor and the Corporation Counsel.

Attached for your consideration is a resolution authorizing the City to apply for and accept a grant of \$25,000 from the Connecticut Office of Health Strategy (OHS) for Phase II of the Health Enhancement Community (HEC) Pre-Planning Project.

The HEC Pre-Planning Project Phase II grant funds will allow the Department to continue to engage in an iterative process with OHS to design an equitable Health Enhancement Community covering Hartford, as well as engage and solicit feedback from Hartford residents.
