### **COURT OF COMMON COUNCIL**

City of Hartford, June 8, 2020

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Chapter VIII, Section 3(b)(ii) of the Charter, the Court of Common Council (the “Council”) is permitted to obtain legal advice on a wide range of topics in addition to the advice of Corporation Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 2-47 of Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of Hartford enumerates the specific qualifications of the position of Legislative and Legal Advisor to the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, Pursuant to the Code, the Council President wishes to appoint an attorney, to the position of Legislative and Legal Advisor; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Council hereby empowers the Council President to select a Legislative and Legal Advisor to serve the Court of Common Council who is a Hartford resident and at an hourly rate of pay not to exceed \$250.00.
